

Special Olympics Area 29 Year in Review 2010

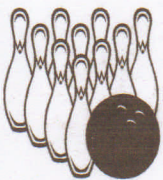


Basketball 2010 was a different kind of year for our teams. We had an all guys team & an all ladies team from Hillsdale. The guys team brought home 3rd place ribbons & the ladies team brought home Silver medals.



Our 1st Annual Bowl A Thon was held on April 24th 2010 & we had a good outcome of athletes & adults who came for a day of fun & fund-raising. We made a little over \$4,000 to help send our athletes to sporting competitions throughout the year.

Summer Games were held June 3rd-5th.



We took 57 athletes. 34 of them did singles bowling and brought home a total of 10 Gold , 5 Silver , 7 Bronze medals, four 4th place ,five 5th place and three 6th place ribbons. That means we had 17 teams of doubles for bowling and they brought home 3 Gold , 4 Silver , 2 Bronze medals, five 4th place, two 5th place and one 6th place ribbons. (They got their own medal or ribbon but together placed as mentioned). We had a volleyball team that consisted of 9 players and they brought home a Bronze medal.

We had 9 athletes who competed in aquatics and they brought home 9 Gold , 4 Silver , 5 Bronze medals, two 4th place ribbons. They had two free relay teams one that was 4X25 and one that was 4X50 and they both brought home Bronze medals for their teams. We had 5 athletes who competed in Track & Field events and they brought home a total of 3 Gold , 4 Silver, 3 Bronze medals,, one 4th place and two 5th place



We did our annual Spring Games at Adrian college and this consists of track & field events where ribbons are given for each of the events. We also sold souvenirs this year for the first time & that went well.



We had a softball team travel to St. Johns for tournament play & brought home a Bronze medal.



We took 3 teams to Warren, Mi. Oct 15th and 16th for soccer tournaments. The Red Hawks coached by Lori Eichler brought home Bronze Medals. The Black Hawks coached by Mildred Flower and they brought home 4th place ribbons. The Hillsdale Hawks coached by Candi McCullough and brought home 4th place ribbons.
