Emergency Information

Should a medical situation, emergency, or injury occur during the Games, please contact the Games medical staff at Grand Traverse Resort & Spa (GTRS), the Schuss ski patrol room, or the Howe Arena medical staff.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Lost Athlete

In the case of lost athlete(s), report or direct them to the nearest Games Committee or medical staff member. They will look after the athlete for 15 minutes. If at GTRS and no one is available to help, call the Nerve Center or take the lost athlete there. The athlete will remain there until an Area Director or chaperone comes to get them. The procedure is the same at all venue sites.

Crowd Disruption

If there is an immediate threat, take cover or evacuate and, if possible, notify 911 immediately providing as many details as possible (location, physical description, etc.). When safe to do so, assist in getting delegations to a safe location. Do not engage the armed, aggressive, or threatening individual(s).

Nerve Center

In order to keep you up-to-date during the Games, the Nerve Center will notify all rooms by phone of any changes. This update will include information on weather conditions, schedule changes, etc. The Nerve Center is located in GTRS Michigan Ballroom C. Special Olympics Michigan's website will also be updated regularly through out the duration of the event (www.somi.org).

GENERAL INFORMATION

Athlete Wristbands

Athlete wristbands will be in the Area Director box given upon arrival at the Games and must be worn at all times. They serve as meal tickets and as a means of identification. An orange band signifies special medical conditions. If a band is lost, report immediately to the Nerve Center for a replacement. Wristbands will also be issued for athlete guests.

Sports Information

Competition bibs will be given to each non-skating athlete and must be worn during all practices, time trials, and finals competition. The number on the bib or the athlete's name may be used to call athletes for heats. If a bib is lost, report immediately to the Nerve Center for a replacement. Only athletes with bibs that have black numbers may ride the chairlift.

Severe Weather

In the case of extreme weather, events will be delayed or canceled until we can safely resume. Delays will only occur in the morning and may last up to one hour. Lack of snow or other conditions, which do not allow an event to be held, will be dealt with on an individual basis. All changes will be posted in the Nerve Center.

Prohibited activities

- No smoking at competition venues. All hotel rooms and restaurants are non-smoking. Smoking is only allowed in designated areas.
- No pets allowed in hotel or at venue sites.
- No swimming allowed for the safety of our entire delegation.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Uniforms

Uniform guidelines are strictly enforced. All athletes must compete in the appropriate uniform. Athletes may not wear denim when competing at any venue site or disqualification will result.
